Brookshire-Katy Drainage District (BKDD) Permit Process

WHO IS BKDD?

BKDD is a government entity with permitting authority since 1961 for drainage related projects within the southeast portion of Waller County. We oversee drainage infrastructure to ensure public safety and mitigate flood risks in our jurisdiction. BKDD collaborates with various agencies for compliance and effective flood control.

WHY YOU NEED A BKDD PERMIT

Any construction or development within BKDD boundaries may require a permit. The process ensures safety, protects drainage, systems, prevents flooding, and meets state and federal environmental regulations.

STEPS TO APPLY

- **1. Review Requirements** Review BKDD Rules and Regulations, available on our website, to understand design standards, submittal requirements, and fees.
- **2. Submit Application** Complete the on-line forms. Upon instruction, deliver the required hard copy documents and payment to BKDD.
- **3. Approval Process** BKDD reviews the application and may request revisions.
- 4. Before Start Construction and Closeout Provide BKDD at least 48 hours' notice prior to start construction. After construction completion, submit as-built plans and the engineer's certification to BKDD.
